## ***STOP AIDS board says Walk to STOP AIDS will continue***

As it stands now, STOP AIDS will continue with the 22nd Annual Walk to STOP AIDS to be held at Sawyer Point on Sunday, September 18, according to its board of directors.

“It is essential for STOP AIDS to continue this important event if we are to continue with HIV testing and prevention programs.” the board said.

Full Walk announcements will be made as soon as possible.

Unfortunately, and as you may know, due to continuing financial struggles at STOP AIDS, the State of Ohio Department of Health reduced their funding by more than \$700,000 and they lost their ability to provide case management services for those living with HIV and were forced to lay off the entire case management

staff.

Fortunately, Caracole was awarded the funding and has continued providing services to all of STOP AIDS clients - and they have hired most of the case management staff from STOP AIDS.

Additionally, the City of Cincinnati Health Department denied STOP AIDS their Ohio Department of Health funding of more than \$100,000 which covered the HIV testing and prevention program and staff.

Consequently, STOP AIDS was forced to lay off all remaining staff. Currently, there is no prevention education being offered in the community yet the board is working diligently to ensure STOP AIDS continues these outreach and testing programs in the near future

with a partner agency to continue the mission of fighting HIV/AIDS through education and testing.

First and foremost, the board thanks you all for your continuing loyalty and willingness to be supportive. “Without our wonderful supporters and volunteers, STOP AIDS could never have been as successful in delivering much needed education and services to the community for so many years,” the board continued.

“Please do not lose hope for hope, dedication, and hard work are what we have left. We hope to prevail and come out of this situation with a sustainable solution in the area of prevention, education and testing, which can continue the effective and life-saving programs the

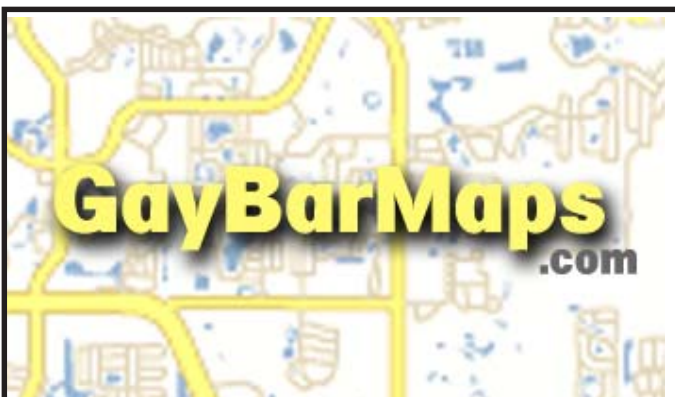
