On Ohio Ballot initiatives, Equality Cincinnati PAC urges a NO vote on Issue 2, which would repeal what has become known as Senate Bill 5.

years to come,” Wagner added.

Scott Knox, a prominent openly Gay Attorney said, “Until we have state or federal protection for employment discrimination based on sexual orientation and gender identity, our best protection comes from union contracts.”

Knox added, “SB5 puts those contracts at risk, weakens unions, and therefore jeopardizes the protections LGBT workers get from union contracts.” Equality Cincinnati PAC will host a meet and greet with endorsed candidates on October 13th from 5:30 p.m.-8 p.m. at Scene Ultra Lounge, Downtown.
